PLANNING COMMITTEE

NUNA's Planning Committee met for the first time on Monday, June 10, at the First English Lutheran Church to commence the neighborhood land use plan that will be incorporated into the Sector 1 Plan. The Sector 1 Plan will become a part of Austin's Comprehensive Land Use Plan.

About 15 people attended the meeting, representing all four quadrants. After a short discussion of the neighborhood planning process in Austin, the Committee decided to conduct a survey of the residents in the neighborhood. An attempt will be made to find a U.T. student who might be interested in writing NUNA's Neighborhood Plan as a professional report or a thesis. (Anybody interested?)

A long work session by a dedicated group, led by Jerry Roemisch, prepared a draft of the survey. At the second Planning Committee meeting, on June 24, the survey was approved, with only a few changes.

Participants in the survey will be randomly selected. Each response is very important to the success of the survey. If you receive the questionnaire, your answers will make a difference, so please be sure to return it to the Planning Committee.

The Planning Committee has reviewed the information in the Neighborhood Self-Help Planning Kit, provided by the City. This kit includes zoning, aerial and topographic maps.
