### NEIGHBORHOOD NEWS NOTES

The August Neighborhood Meeting will be held on Monday, August 5, starting at 7:00 p.m., at the First English Lutheran Church, Whitis at 30th St.. The agenda will include discussion on some of the items detailed here.

During the last couple of months, further activity on the development of surplus land at the the Austin State School (along 38th St. between Guadalupe and Lamar) has been getting underway. Although nothing formal has come forth proposals are currently being entertained from private development groups. It is with this and later stages of the development process that the Planned Unit Development Ordinance that the neighborhood helped develop comes into play.

In case you missed it, the June Neighborhood Meeting offered an ear full on the problems that the police force is experiencing. In addition, Officer Cox made a challenge to the neighborhood, as he has done with other groups city wide, to support greater funding for the police department and with the City budget process just starting more information on this proposition should be forthcoming.
