Exuberant, intact Tudor Revival style house retains a high level of all 7 aspects of integrity, reflects historic and architectural trends of its time, and contributes to the historic district.

1-2-story Spanish Eclectic house with stucco siding, flat and gabled roof forms with red clay tiles. Clay tile awnings. Arched front and side porches; front enclosed with glass and accessed by French doors. Twisted plaster columns with Corinthian capitals. Arched multi-light window on second floor; paired wood casements on first floor front. Extensive plantings obscure house and details somewhat. Spanish Eclectic house retains a high level of all 7 aspects of integrity despite glass porch enclosure, reflects historic and architectural trends of its time, and contributes to the historic district.

Building History

The Del Curto-Nowotny House is located on Laurel Lane in Aldridge Place Reserve, a section of the Aldridge Place platted in 1924. The Del Curto-Nowotny House is an interesting example of the Spanish Colonial Revival style applied to a ranch house. The Spanish Colonial Revival style reached its zenith of popularity in the 1920s, after being introduced at the 1915 Panama Pacific Exhibition in San Diego. The style was most popular in those areas of the country with a Hispanic heritage, especially California, Arizona, New Mexico, and Texas. Characteristics of the style include a low-pitched tile roof, and an ornamented and arched or arcaded entry, all of which appear on the Del Curto-Nowotny House. The rock accent course on the walls and outlining the segmental-arched entryway, as well as the prominent rock chimney on the front of the house are especially notable.

The Del Curto-Nowotny House was designed by prominent Austin architect Roy L. Thomas (1887-1968). Thomas was born in San Marcos and went on to design numerous houses, churches, and schools throughout Central Texas during his career, including the Texas Hotel (now the Stephen F. Austin), 701 Congress Avenue (1924); the Herbert Bohn House, 1301 W. 29th Street (1938); Robert E. Lee Elementary School, 3308 Hampton Road (1939); and the Tarrytown Methodist Church, 2701 Exposition Boulevard (1947). Thomas had a prolific residential design business.

Significant Persons Associated with Building and Dates(s) of Association

The Del Curto-Nowotny House was home to Arno "Shorty" Nowotny who dedicated his life to student affairs at The University of Texas. Dean Nowotny made many far reaching contributions to The University of Texas, among them the Texas Cowboys, Alpha Phi Omega, the Arno Nowotny Internships, the Friar Society, and the original funding for Memorial Stadium. The Arno Nowotny Internships were funded by the Ex-Students Association's Foundation for Texas Excellence through direct contributions from the dean's friends and those whose lives he has touched.

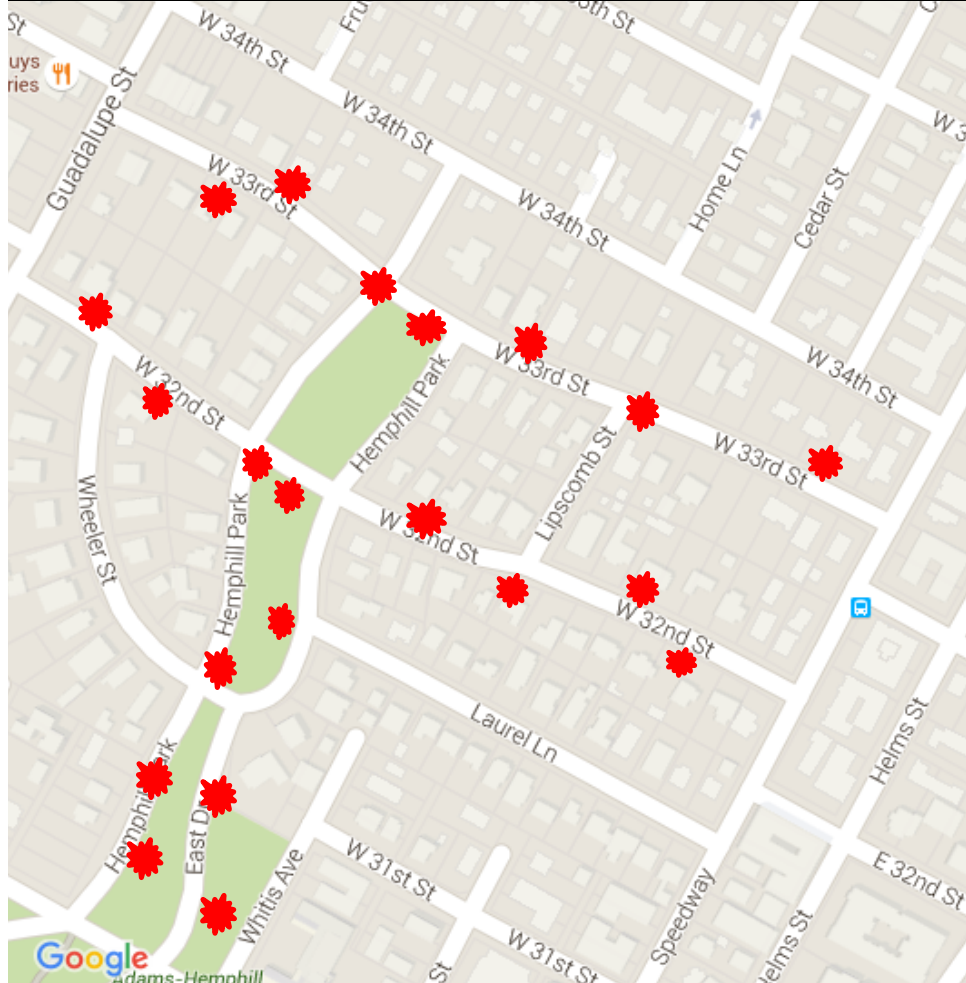

Former Austin mayor Lewis Hancock surveyed and platted Aldridge Place in 1912. It is likely that roads and streetlights were added at that time. Historically, amenities such as entry gates and street lights were erected as soon as the plat was filed to identify and promote new, undeveloped subdivisions.
